Year 11 students will have a Careers Interview to assist with them with choosing post 16 options and to understand what is available. Post 16 Options that are available:-

<u>Tor Bridge High 6th Form</u> - You can apply to study 3 A Levels or Level 3 subjects from; Art and Design, Biology, Business Studies, Chemistry, English Literature & Language, Engineering (BTEC), Geography, Health & Social Care (BTEC), History, Law, Maths, Creative & Performing Arts, Physics, Psychology, Sociology, Sport (BTEC) and Core Maths. The entry requirements are five GCSEs at grade 5 to include English and Maths, a grade 6 is usually expected in the chosen subject, some subjects also have further entrance requirements.

<u>Sixth form at another school</u> - worth considering if you travel a long way or want to study A levels not taught at Tor Bridge. Or if you want to gain a vocational qualification/skill with a training provider.

Further Education Colleges and Independent Training Providers

There are a range of FE colleges and training providers in Plymouth offering a variety of vocational qualifications, these include:-

- Access Creative College offers a range of courses in esports, gaming and music
- <u>Achievement Training</u> courses and apprenticeships in animal care, beauty, business, childcare, hairdressing, health & social care, IT, teaching and learning.
- Arts University Plymouth (formerly PCA)- offer a range of art and design courses
- Callywith College New FE college in Bodmin offering vocational and A Level course
- <u>City College Plymouth</u> offer a range of Vocational courses as well as retake GCSEs in Maths, English, Biology and Chemistry

- <u>Construction Training South West (CTSW)</u> offers courses and apprenticeships in construction trades as well as Commis Chef
- <u>Cornwall College</u> (to include: Duchy & Bicton College, campuses at Saltash, Stoke Climsland, Budleigh Salterton) - for animal & veterinary, land based, plus a range of other courses
- <u>Discovery College</u> offers courses in Business, Childcare, Health & Social Care, Public Services, Sport and Travel & Tourism,
- Exeter College lots of courses on offer as well as apprenticeships
- Focus Training apprenticeships in Care, Early Years, Electrical, Plumbing, Gas,
- GHQ Training training courses in Hair, Beauty, Nails and Support Teaching and Learning
- Greenlight Training construction apprenticeship provider
- Military Preparation College Plymouth preparation for a life in one of the armed forces as well as providing a learning programme
- <u>Skills Group</u> offering apprenticeships and courses ranging from automotive, hairdressing, business, construction and childcare.
- <u>South Devon College</u> FE College based in Torbay covering a wide range of subjects and sectors
- <u>UTC</u> (University Technical College) for engineering related courses
