<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accept responsibility for my own learning with the support of my teachers. • Review my progress and success regularly with my teachers and set and receive targets to improve my performance. • Attend Academic Mentoring appointments with my Parents/Carers and tutor. • Be a curious learner by showing a thirst for knowledge by asking questions and participating actively in lessons. • Be a reflective learner by expecting to redraft work and learn from the feedback I am given. • Move around the buildings calmly and quietly and recognise that running around and shouting is an outdoor activity for the MUGA or playing fields. • Not drop litter, vandalise or damage school property. • Contribute to school life e.g. by taking on leadership positions to improve myself and/or taking advantage of all enrichment opportunities that will build my character and make me resilient • Wear my school uniform with pride, looking business smart in Tor Bridge High knee length skirt. or Tor Bridge High trousers white shirt, school tie, jacket and black soled footwear (no logos). • Accept that students are allowed one piercing only in each ear lobe (no other part of the ear, face or body should have piercings), no jewellery other than a wrist watch is permitted. False or overly long nails are not allowed. Nail varnish should not be worn. Hair which is shorter than grade 2 or dyed hair is not allowed. I will also accept that hoodies are not allowed in school, and if I bring one into to school my tutor will confiscate it until the end of the school day. I will wear my blazer every day until after the May half term when summer uniform applies. • Keep my phone in my bag during the school day and only take it out at break and lunch times. I will not wear headphones unless I have permission. • Have an attendance record that exceeds 96% and be punctual to lessons, tutorial sessions, and assemblies. • Follow the Behaviour for Learning Policy at all times and follow the consequences I am given. • Read and commit to following the Anti-Bullying contract below: <p>This Anti-Bullying contract was written and updated for 2017 - 2018 by Tor Bridge High Students</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) I promise to treat all members of Tor Bridge High with respect by speaking to them politely and helping people in need. 2) I promise to treat people's belongings and the school environment with respect. 3) I promise not to say things that will knock down people's confidence. 4) I promise not to use verbal or physical aggression and be polite at all times. 5) I promise not to use social media to abuse or threaten other people as this is cyber bullying. 6) I promise not to use racist, sexist, homophobic or disablist language. 7) I promise not to laugh at someone for their gender, sexuality, interests, religion or culture. 8) I will not get involved in any 'sexting', online aggression or any other online behaviours that can harm me or others 9) If I see any of the things listed above happening or I am involved, I promise to report this to my School Office. If I am involved then I promise to accept any consequence given. <p>Student Sign: _____</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Show interest in my child's education by celebrating their achievements and agreeing to school sanctions that support their learning and development. • Support my child to develop a strong work ethic and also take pride in their work by ensuring they have a quiet place to complete home-learning. • Speak to my child's tutor if they I/we have any concerns that may affect my child's progress or development. • Attend meetings including Academic Mentoring and/or Subject Parents/Carers Evenings. • Encourage and motivate my child to overcome personal and academic challenges to increase their resilience and future success in life. • Monitor my child if they take a part –time job to ensure it does not impact negatively on their learning. • Encourage my child to take care of themselves through healthy eating, exercise and regular sleep patterns so that they manage their workload and own wellbeing effectively. • Buy and ensure my child wears their school uniform with pride, Tor Bridge High knee length skirt or Tor Bridge High trousers white shirt, school tie, jacket and black soled footwear (no logos). • Not allow my child to wear more than one piercing in each ear lobe (no other part of the ear, face or body should have piercings), and not let them wear any jewellery, other than a wrist watch, Remind my child false or overlong nails are not allowed and nail varnish shouldn't be worn, Ensure my child does not have their hair less than a grade 2 or dyed hair I will not allow my child to wear a hoody to school.
